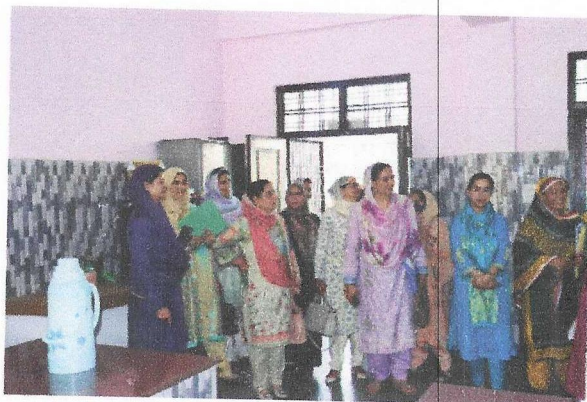
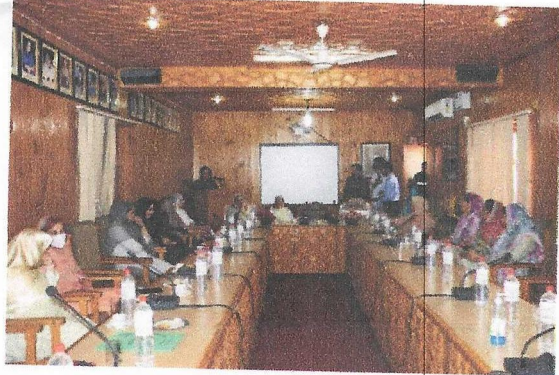
A good number of Alumni participated in the meeting.
