Report on Medical Aid Camp & Yoga Mahautsav

College Health center and NSS wing in collaboration with Health and Wellness center AYUSH under the patronage of madam principal Prof. (Dr.) Neelofar Bhat organized one day program on three activities:

- 1. Talk on Health benefits of millet in diet,
- 2. Medical Aid camp, and
- 3. Yoga session as a prelude to 9th International Day of Yoga.

First session started with the welcome address by Dr.Nusrat Parveen (Member Health Centre committee). She elaborated the concept and importance of Ayush system in promoting general wellness. In her address she stressed that the Ayush medicine is free from side effects and their rewards are long lasting. It assists in strengthening and boosting natural immune system.

Dr Roohi Tabassum (Incharge Medical Officer AYUSH Unit JLNM and state Yoga master trainer Department of AYUSH) deliberated on the importance of Millets in diet.
