PROCESS OF ADMISSION FOR ACADEMIC SESSION 2026-27 Admissions on the basis of IO+2 Merit:

All undergraduate admissions for the session 2026-27 across all Government Degree Colleges in J&K shall be granted on Non-CUET basis as per 10+2 scores/merit.

Centralized Admission Portal: All students shall be required to register and apply through a Centralized Admission Portal. The portal link and registration details shall be notified separately.

Preference-based College and Course Allotment: Students shall be required to submit their course and college preferences on the Centralized Admission Portal. The allotment of colleges shall be made on the basis of 10+2 merit and the preferences submitted by the candidates.
