

1st session "Impact Lecture Series-II"

on "Entrepreneurship And Economic Growth"

October 9, 2021

The IIC of the college in line with its endeavour to impart culture of innovation and entrepreneurship among students organised impact Lecture series. The event was mainly aimed at sensitizing students about entrepreneurship and its role in the economic development.

PROCEEDINGS:

The event was hosted by IPR coordinator, Ms. Sana Bala who welcomed the gathering and spoke about the aim of the event. The programme was presided by the principal of the institution, Prof. (Dr.) Tabasum Rafiq who delivered the welcome address. In her introductory address, Professor Tabassum Rafiq talked about the importance of IIC in nurturing the young minds and encouraging creative ideas among students by providing them with the platform. She also stressed upon the importance of impact lecture series. Conducting impact lecture sessions in HEIs is one of the approaches under the IIC program to support IIC institutions to generate awareness on innovation.
