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A. About IIC Institute

The Government College for Women, Nawakadal, situated on the Southern bank of river Jehlum is the only institution of Higher Education for Women ideally located in Shehr- e -Khas (Down Town area of Srinagar city). The institution is dedicated to excellence in the field of higher learninig & committed to the cause of empowerment of women through the instrument of the education. It was established in 1961 with Arts and Science subjects and a Teaching faculty of 19 members with just 50 students. Presently it is the only Women Institution in Kashmir Valley offering Commerce & management Courses.

Since its establishment the College gradually achieved multidisciplinary character and at present the college offers various undergraduate courses in Arts, Science, Commerce, Social Science and few postgraduate programs along with some professional and vocational courses. Existing courses are restructured from time to time to make them relevant side by side with the introduction of new courses.



From the President's Desk




Convener's overview about IIC


